My objectives today is to exploring answers to 2 major questions:

- 1) The 1<sup>st</sup> questions is "Why did the all-Wise God decide that 'tongues' (Spirit languages), should accompany the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on baby Church as the universal sign. (Much of the church in the West without blurting it out loud'. 'Yeah God what were you thinking? (This is the big picture overview)"
- 2) The 2<sup>nd</sup> Question is "What are some of the main benefits to the ordinary believer in using a Spiritual Language in their everyday life?" (This is the individual overview)

### I. What was God's Big Plan

a. On the day of Pentecost all the believers were meeting together in one place. Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm, and it filled the house where they were sitting. Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them. And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability. At that time there were devout Jews from every nation living in Jerusalem. When they heard the loud noise, everyone came running, and they were bewildered to hear their own languages being spoken by the believers. They were completely amazed. "How can this be?" they exclaimed. "These people are all from Galilee, and yet we hear them speaking in our own native languages! Here we are— Parthians, Medes, Elamites, people from Mesopotamia, Judea, Cappadocia, Pontus, the province of Asia, Phrygia, Pamphylia, Egypt, and the areas of Libya around Cyrene, visitors from Rome (both Jews and converts to Judaism), Cretans, and Arabs. And we all hear these people speaking in our own languages about the wonderful things God has done!" They stood there amazed and perplexed. "What can this mean?" they asked each other. But others in the crowd ridiculed them, saying, "They're just drunk, that's all!" Acts 2:1-13 NLT

# What are the main personal benefits to a Spiritual Prayer Language?a. Intimacy with the Lord:

<sup>2</sup> For one who speaks in a private prayer language speaks not to men but to God; for no one understands him, but he utters mysteries in the Spirit. <sup>5</sup> Now I want you all to speak in a private prayer language, but even more to prophesy. The one who prophesies is greater than the one who speaks in tongues, unless someone interprets, so that the church may be built up. <sup>13</sup> Therefore, one who speaks in a tongue should pray that he may interpret. <sup>14</sup> For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays but my mind is unfruitful. <sup>15</sup> What am I to do? I will pray with my spirit, but I will pray with my mind also; I will sing praise with my spirit, but I will sing with my mind also. <sup>16</sup> Otherwise, if you give thanks with your spirit, how can anyone in the position of an outsider say "Amen" to your thanksgiving when he does not know what you are saying? <sup>17</sup> For you may be giving thanks well enough, but the other person is not being built up. <sup>18</sup> I thank

God that I speak in tongues more than all of you. 1 Corinthians 14:2-5, 13-18

### b. Personal Development and Growth

The one who speaks in a spiritual language builds up himself.... 1 Cor 14:4A

But you, beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ that leads to eternal life. Jude 20-21

### c. Advanced Spiritual Warfare
