TOOL # 4 - Healing Prayer

Steps: Ask, Discern, Activate, Follow -up

**30 Second Theology-** We believe the bible teaches that all of the gifts, including healing are in operation today and are commanded by the inspired scriptures to be eagerly desired and pursued. They demonstrate the Kingdom, accompanied by gospel preaching, and meant not for a super few, but for all His disciples . When it comes to Healing and if its God's will, this is what we know from the Bible- There was no sickness or disease in the Garden, and there's none in heaven. The Gospels accounts tell us that Everyone SINGLE person who came to Jesus in need of healing was healed. NOT ONCE- did He ever say, I'm sorry, God has ordained this sickness for your good and the Father's glory to teach you

perseverance. That's not to say our character can't be developed in suffering, but I'll attribute the sickness to the devil and Sin and redemption to God- Therefore, we can pray with confidence, not "If it be your will, but Yes Lord it is your will, Be healed in Jesus name. And if nothing happens in the physical, I'll go back to my prayer closet, cry out to God for more revelation, refusing to blame nor doubt his goodness. I'll trust that God's promises are one more prayer closer to being fulfilled. And if a miracle does occur- God will get the praise, not me, and that person will definitely be glad I took the risk. Regardless, of the end result, as long as we walk in LOVE, demonstrating his Heart/compassion, I can never go wrong!
