III Cause of Blessings

- 1 Listening to God's Voice
- 2 Obeying God's Word and God's Voice
- 3 Pronouncement by Other People (Authority Figures, Self)
- 4 Generational Obedience and Love for the Lord

III Cause of Curses (Proverbs 26:2)

- 1 Disregarding and/or Disobeying God Word and God Voice
- 2 Idolatry or the Occult (taproots and lateral roots)
- 3 Dishonoring your parents
- 4 Illicit or Unnatural Sex
- 5 Injustice to the weak or helpless
- 6 Trusting in the your own abilities, your own works or the those of others.
- 7 Stealing or Purjury
- 8 Robbing God
Words spoken by people with authority over your life like parents, teachers, coaches, husbands, wives, pastors, government officials, police.
- 9 Self Imposed curses
- 12 Curse pronounced by those empowered by Satan
- 13 Anti-Semitism
- 14 Illegitimacy

- 2 Physical, mental and emotional Health
- 3 Productivity, fruitfulness and fertility
- 4 Financial Sufficiency and Prosperity

- 6 God's Providence, Protection and Favor
- 7 Family Cohesion and Unity
- 8 Marital Faithfulness and Sexual Health
- 9 General satisfaction and happiness with life

IV Outcome of Curses (Generational)

- 1 Mental illness and/or emotional breakdown
- 2 Repeated or chronic sicknesses (especially if hereditary)
- 3 Barrenness, a tendency to miscarry
- 4 Breakdown of marriage and family alienation
- 5 Adultery, Sexual Abuse and Perversion in your family
- 6 Continual financial insufficiency and lack
- 7 Calamity and accident-prone
A history of tradgies, suicides and unnatural or untimely deaths
- 8 Difficulty in beliving in God and attraction to false religions/beliefs
- 10 10. Life of Frustration, opposition and futility

madness, driven mad (28, 34); 1 confusion of heart or confusion of mind (28); a trembling heart or an anxious mind (65); anguish of soul or a despairing heart (65).

plague or plagued with diseases (21); consumption or wasting disease (22); severe burning fever (22); inflammation (22); incurable boils (27, 35); tumors (27); scabs or festering sores (27); incurable itch (27); blindness (28); extraordinary, fearful, prolonged plagues (59); serious and prolonged sicknesses or severe and lingering diseases (59); every other kind of sickness and plague (61).

18 Cursed shall be the fruit of your body and the produce of land and the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks.

vs 54-55 The sensitive and very refined man among you will be hostile toward his brother, toward the wife of his bosom, and toward the rest of his children whom he leaves behind, so that he will not give any of them the flesh of his children whom he will eat, because he has nothing left in the siege and desperate straits in which your enemy shall distress you at all your gates.

Others with have sexual relations with your spouse, perversions, incest, homosexuality, and bestiality,

"Cursed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl" or trough (17); "you shall not prosper in your ways" or you will be unsuccessful in everything you do (29). The full outworking of this curse, however, is most graphically presented in verses 47-48: "Because you did not serve the LORD your God with joy and gladness of heart, for the abundance of everything, therefore you shall serve your enemies, whom the LORD will send against you, in hunger, in thirst, in nakedness, and in need of everything."
25-35 defeat, madness, oppressed, plundered, failure, violence
